A licensed nursing home administrator, Binenfeld is active on the community, regional and national levels of health care services. He is an Ohio Delegate to the American Association of Homes and Services to the Aging, a member of the Public Policy Committee of the Association of Ohio Philanthropic Homes and Housing for the Aging, a board member of the American Diabetes Association – Cincinnati Chapter and Board Chairman of Cincinnati's Victory Neighborhood Services Association.

Mr. Binenfeld earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Anthropology from State University of New York and a Master's degree in Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

A not-for-profit organization, Mary Scott offers intermediate, skilled, and respite care to a racially diverse population. Many of those served are dependent upon Medicaid.
